RULES FOR SELLING CANDY (must be followed)

\$36.00 DEPOSIT must be paid before receiving first 60 bars of candy.

This \$36 will be applied to your camp fee at the end of sales.

You will only receive ONE box of 60 bars of candy at a time.

Each bar sells for \$1.00. When you return \$60 for bars then you can get another box of candy.

For each \$60 you return for chocolate, \$24 will be applied toward camp fees.

You will have **two** months to sell candy once you pick up your first box.

All candy money is good for the 2017 camp year ONLY. Funds will not be rolled over.

Coins **WILL NOT** be accepted. You will need to change in bills before you can get another box.

You **CANNOT** sell candy bars at school.
