We are excited for you to be a part of our 4-H program. As a 4-Her you can attend 4-H summer camp with us. We know camp can be expensive so we have a solution for you.

Our candy for camp program was a great success last year. We had 28 kids earn over \$3,700 towards the cost of 4-H Camp.

This year we will sell the Van Wyk \$1 dollar bars. Each box sold will profit the camper \$24.00. After much consideration in cost and profit for the camper, we decided to continue with this candy bar option this year. We highly encourage you to sell as many boxes as possible to help reduce the cost of 4-H Camp.

If you are interested in participating in Candy for Camp, please return this contract and \$36 deposit to the Extension Office. The deposit will be credited to your camp fees. We will sell candy in two month rotations. Our first candy cycle will begin December 1st. I have included the candy cycle dates below. The first 20 to sign a Candy for Camp contract and pay their deposit will be allowed to sell candy bars.
